

Trail Guide & Points of Interest

Tahquitz Falls
Tahquitz was well Mouth of the Canyon. Entrance to Tahquitz Canyon. Named more on 2000 years ago by Kengnug "Great Chief" of the Agua Caliente Indians.

Left Mouth of Gray Tap
Left mouth of Gray Tap is in the middle of the mouth of Tahquitz Canyon. Named by Goyie he was the first to find water here. It is the mouth of the creek which flows down to the village for drinking and irrigation.

Spotted Rock
One of the oldest Agua Caliente Indian dwelling sites found here. A small rock shelter in a shaded place. Artifacts found here date more than 1,500 years.

Cook wo wit Piled Boulders
U.S. Geological Survey Gaging Station built in 1947 by USGS. A cold-use today. An ancient rock shelter where artifacts, dating back thousands of years have been found.

The Legend of Tahquitz

Kahogu was the first shaman created by Makot, the Creator of all things. Tahquitz had much power and in the beginning he used his power for the good of all people. Tahquitz became the guardian spirit of all animals and he used his power to help them. He would use his power to help the sick and to help the poor. He began to use his power to harm the Agua Caliente people. The Agua Caliente became angry and they banished Tahquitz to the canyon that now bears his name. This is the reason why the Agua Caliente people do not like to go into the canyon. Below the towering rock known today as Spotted Rock, it is said that his spirit still haunts the area. His spirit can be seen as a large gray ghostly figure walking around the night sky. The Agua Caliente people believe that when the Ser Jacobs Mountain, the shaking of the ground and crashing of boulders are attributed to Tahquitz as he strolls about the region.
